

# 6 WAYS TO SEARCH FOR A JOB

WHILE CURRENTLY EMPLOYED

## WITHOUT RISKING YOUR CURRENT JOB!



### BUILD RELATIONSHIPS

**BEFORE YOU HAVE A DIRECT NEED FOR THEIR SERVICES,** invest the time & energy in building relationships with recruiters that specialize in your industry.



Like, Comment and Share their posts on LinkedIn, and offer to suggest potential candidates when you see recruiters doing a search in your industry.

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### REACH OUT

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WHEN YOU ARE READY TO START YOUR SEARCH, REACH OUT TO THESE RECRUITERS THAT YOU HAVE IDEALLY ALREADY ESTABLISHED A WORKING RELATIONSHIP WITH, AND LET THEM KNOW OF THE TYPES OF OPPORTUNITIES YOU WOULD BE INTERESTED IN HEARING ABOUT.

Send them an updated resume along with a list of bullet points on the types of roles you would be open to make a change for.

### EXECUNET ALERTS

#### SET UP ALERTS ON EXECUNET.

You will then be alerted to jobs that fall within your scope of interest.



You can then determine if you want to throw your hat in the ring by sending in your resume directly into the company's job portal, or letting your recruiter know of the opening and asking her help in gaining you an interview.

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### POST RESUME

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#### CONSIDER POSTING A BLIND RESUME ON EXECUNET.

For Executives in order to make it truly blind you will be forced to take out quite a bit of pertinent information to prohibit you from being easily identified, so be sure to make up for that by adding additional skills and accomplishments that are not immediately identifying.

It's strongly suggested to make up a unique gmail account that does not reflect your name or any identifying information but remains professional, so that prospective employers can contact you.

### GOOGLE ALERTS

**SET UP GOOGLE ALERTS FOR THE TYPES OF ROLES YOU ARE MOST INTERESTED IN HEARING ABOUT,**

and once you hear about them, either apply directly or bring them to your recruiter's attention, who can ideally be able to present you on a highly confidential basis to the key decision makers within the hiring company.

**Try to be as broad as possible when setting up alerts for your titles in order to cast as wide a net as possible when setting up alerts... try CEO, Chief Executive Officer, President, etc.**

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### MAKE A LIST

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MAKE A LIST OF COMPANIES THAT YOU ARE MOST INTERESTED IN, AND SET UP ALERTS DIRECTLY ON THEIR CAREER PAGES TO BE ALERTED TO NEW POSITIONS.



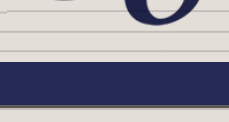
